LOS ANGELES SCHOOL POLICE DEPARTMENT (LASPD)

The LASPD is a full service police department providing law enforcement service to the students, staff, and property of the Los Angeles Unified School District (LAUSD) 24 hours a day, seven days a week.

SUPPORT SERVICES

- **Detective Unit:** Investigates crimes against persons, property crimes, benefit abuse, and serves low-level search warrants.
- **Training and Backgrounds Unit:** Coordinates LASPD recruitment, training, equipment, and Peace Officer Standards and Training compliance. Completes background investigations on all LASPD applicants.
- **Police Activities League (PAL):** Provides opportunities for the youth of the LAUSD to interact with law enforcement and develop core values, ethics, and standards.
- **Records Unit:** Conducts crime analysis for directed enforcement, compiles statistical data, and tracks all Department reports.
- **Citation Control Unit:** Processes all citations issued by the LASPD.
- **Anti-terrorism Unit:** Ancillary assignment to liaison with local, state, and federal agencies to network, identify, and address issues affecting the LAUSD.
- **Public Information Office (PIO):** Provides specific information to the media about law enforcement issues, liaises with the LAUSD PIO, provides information regarding proactive LASPD public projects and events.

FIELD SERVICES

- **Police Communications/Dispatch:** Receives and coordinates all LASPD calls for service, dispatches and oversees all field operations, and makes appropriate notifications.
- **Campus Police Officer (CPO):** Provides law enforcement services, resource expertise, and proactive uniformed presence to students and staff at secondary schools.
- **Patrol Officer:** Provides patrol to six geographic Divisions during the day and three off-hour watches. Provides law enforcement services to students and staff at primary schools, LAUSD offices, and as a back up resource to campus police officers.
- **School Safety Officer (SSO):** Provides uniformed security at secondary schools/ LAUSD facilities.
- **Motor Unit (Motor Strike Force):** Provides traffic enforcement and traffic safety presentations. Rapid response team for strategic incidents.
- **K-9 Unit:** Conducts narcotics, article, and building searches. Makes school safety/drug prevention presentations.
- **Parking Enforcement Unit:** SSOs provide parking enforcement and traffic control at primary and secondary schools.
- **Benefit Abuse Unit (BAU):** Provides investigative services for crimes involving benefit abuse and workers' compensation fraud.
- **Adult School:** provides law enforcement and security services to LAUSD campuses at night.
- **Team (SRT):** Ancillary assignment to respond to strategic/tactical incidents and serve medium level warrants.

DISPATCH/CALLING CHECKLIST

In order to receive prompt and accurate service when calling to report a crime or other emergency incident, please have as much of the following information available for the Police Communications Representative (Police Dispatcher):

Remember: Stay on the phone. Remain calm. Speak clearly.

- What is your name and call back phone number?
- What is your current location?
- What is the type of incident or crime?
- What is the location of the incident or crime?
- When did the crime or incident occur?
- Where did the crime or incident occur?
- Is the crime or incident still occurring (in progress)?
- Are there any weapons involved?
- How many people are involved?
- Is there a victim(s)? If so, what is his/her name(s), if known?
- Is there a suspect(s)? If so, what is his/her name(s), if known?
- Are there any injuries? If so, what are they?
- Are there additional concerns or hazards involved (i.e. Chemicals, Explosives, Unknown Substances, Gas Leak, Narcotics, Ammunition, Fire, etc.)?
- Do you need any additional services (i.e. OEHS, Water and Power, Gas Company, Electric Company, Carpenter, etc.)?
- Are there any traffic issues/concerns (i.e. Accidents, etc.)?
